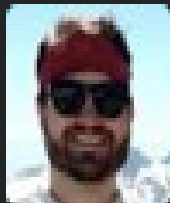
What is ORCID?

Connecting Research and Researchers

ORCID disambiguates names

- Shared names
- Different versions (full name vs. initials)
- Transliteration
- Accents and other ALT characters
- Name changes
- Multiple family names



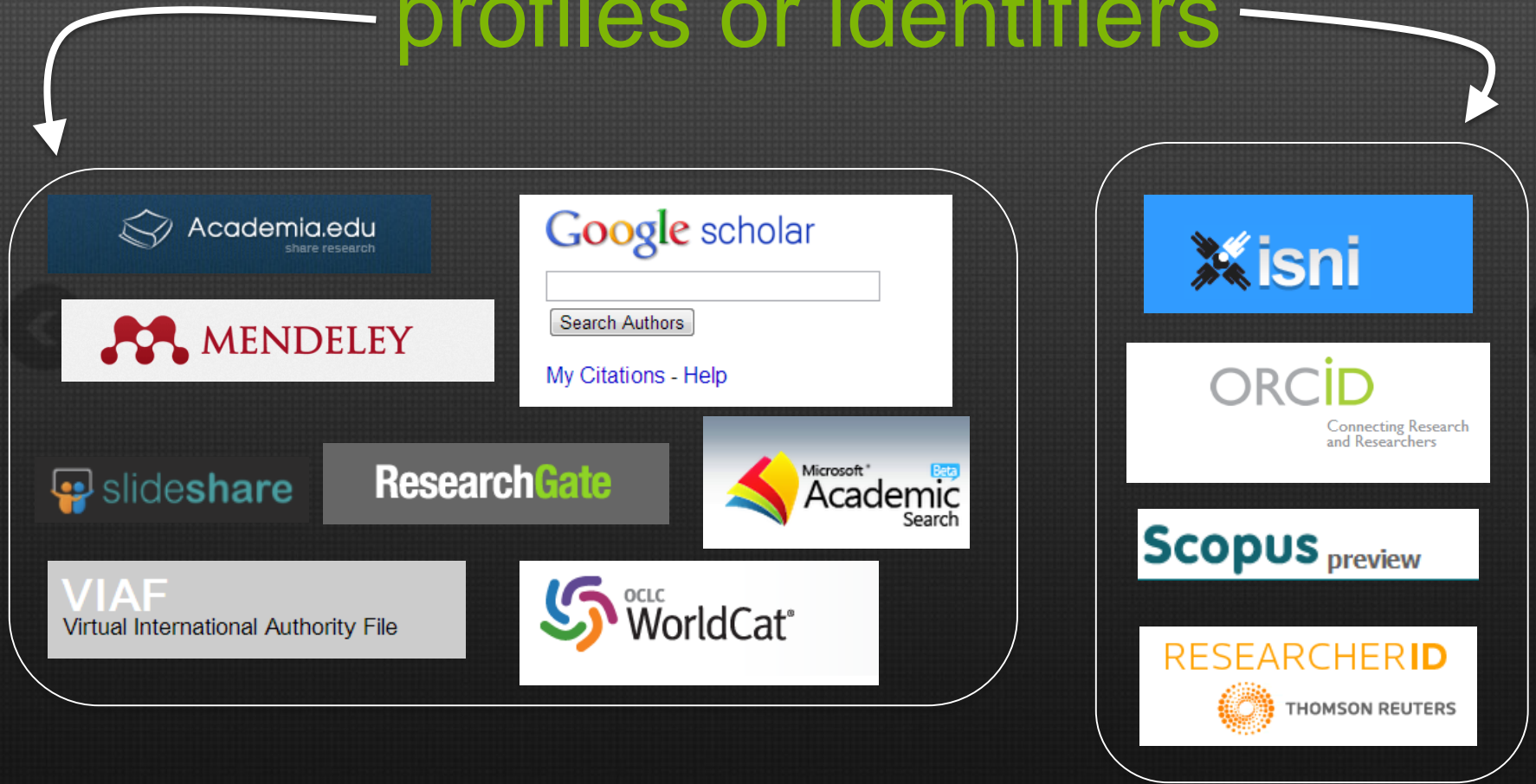

One researcher may have many profiles or identifiers

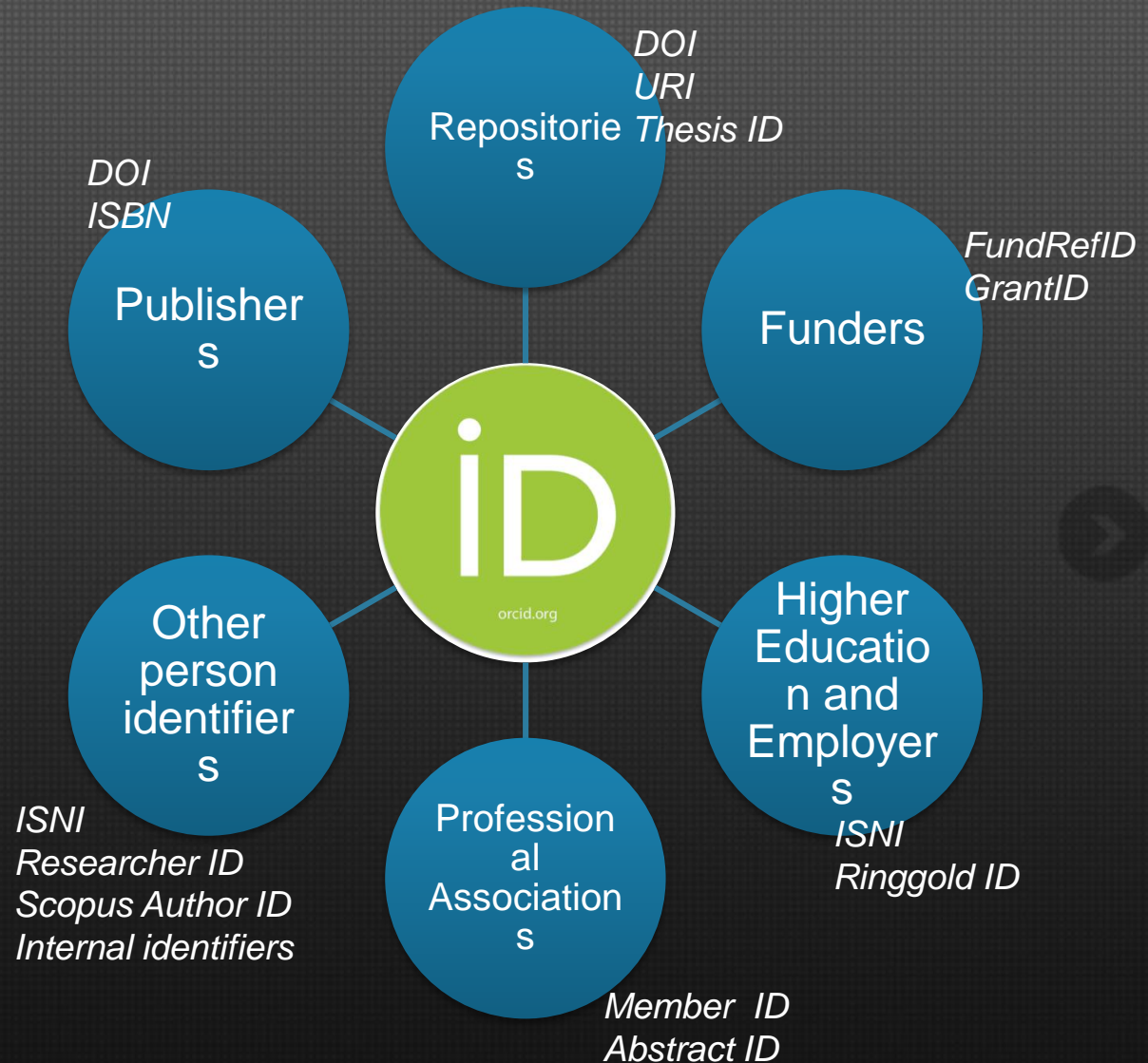


ORCID ID	First name	Last name	Other names

- Free, non-proprietary registry of **persistent unique open** identifiers for researchers
- Community-led initiative supported by member fees
- Open data, software, APIs, and documentation

With other identifiers, ORCID enables machine-readable connections with:

- works
- organizations
- person IDs



- ORCID is an **interdisciplinary** effort
- We have an **international** scope
- ORCID provides foundational services that **improve scholarly communications for *all researchers***

Who uses ORCID?

- 1.65m live ORCID iDs
 - Associated with 4.3m+ DOIs
 - 285k+ linked to works
 - 341k+ linked to education
 - 327k+ linked to employment

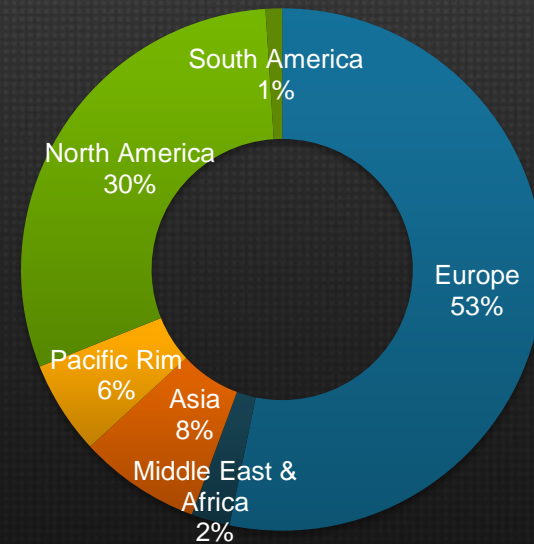
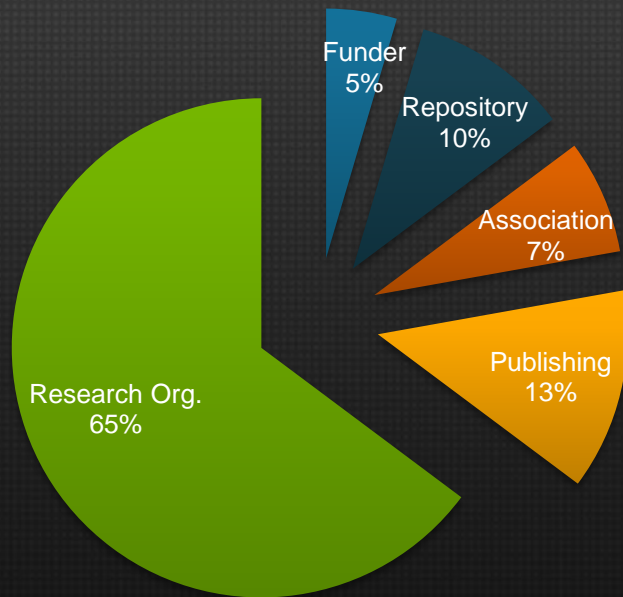
19% first heard about ORCID from their institution

26% use their iD at their university

- 300+ organizations are members
 - Three national consortia agreements signed (Denmark, Italy, UK) with more in progress
 - Australia in progress
- 145 members with live integrations
 - 30+ more in development

75% of respondents agree/strongly agree that integrating ORCID at their organization would support better data

Members and integrations in every region and sector of the international research community



Why ORCID?

“I want the Internet to work better, and persistent identifiers are the way to go”

Researchers

- It's free! And quick! (30 seconds to register)
- Their 'forever' digital name
- Automated updates
 - CrossRef and DataCite
- Enables recognition of their research outputs
- Interoperable across multiple systems

Funders

- Reduced grantee reporting burden
- Connections across programs
- Cross-organizational data visibility for gap-overlap analysis
- Unambiguous tracking of grantee research output and activities
- ORCID iDs for research staff

Research organizations

- Identify and track researchers and scholar
- Monitor and report on research output (across multiple organizations)
- Automated updates for new research activity
- Support OA compliance efforts
- Reduce reporting and admin burden for faculty and staff
- SSO/Federated login

How is

ORCID

being used?

- Dissemination of research results (55%)
- At their institution (26%)
- Applying for grants (14%)

- Auto-update of local systems
- Research results reporting
- OA compliance
- Affiliation validation
- Tracking
grantees/authors/students/members
- And more...
